

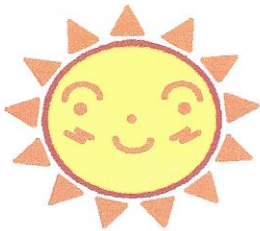

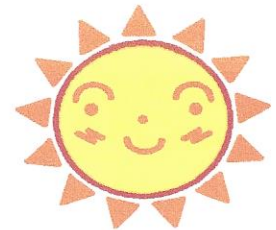
GOOD BYE WINTER!

SUMMER CAMPS (9 weeks)

Start June 26 and end August 25 (Closed July 4th)

We have several options for your child. We offer sign ups by the week or by the day (full or half days)...sign up for as many days that fit your schedule. You can switch between half & full days and add early drop-off or late pick-up.

If your child is attending 3 or more full weeks/full days, you will receive a 5% discount. To be eligible for the discount, the days must be consecutive. We also offer a 5% sibling discount. We strongly recommend advance registration, as space is limited. Brochures/pricing available in our lobby & online.

Half day camp 8:00am-12:00pm or 1:00pm-5pm;
Full day camp 8:00am-5pm;

7:30am early drop off and 5:30pm late pick up is also available (extra charge applies).

SUMMER CLASSES (8 weeks)

Start June 26 and end August 25 (Closed July 3-7).

Schedules are now available in the lobby. Remember, if you are currently a member, your registration is valid thru August 2017, so all you need to do is choose a class or camp to continue during the summer. Stop by the office and reserve your spot today. Note: Summer registration and tuition fees are non-refundable. Camp fees are not transferable.

MARK YOUR CALENDAR! **Fall Registrations will be** **Accepted May 15 – 20**

Registration is a first come, first served basis, so don't wait to register! Stop by the office the week of May 15th.

Early registration allows you to choose your favorite instructor as well as the most convenient time and day.

Your child's coach will be evaluating your child this month and will make Sept. class recommendations. Coaches will hand out blue cards with child's Sept. class recommendation. Bring this to the office the week of May 15th.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO REGISTER:

1. Stop by the office with the blue card which lists your child's recommended level for Sept.
2. A \$45.00 registration fee (non-refundable).
3. You must review your current registration form & update with any changes. We also require a valid MasterCard/Visa on file.





RECITAL NEWS

Recitals will continue to be held on Father's Day weekend. The Preschool Recital (Tot, Adv Tot & Parent/Tot, ages 5 & younger) will be held on Friday night, June 16; Recreational & Cheer Tumbling Recitals (ages 6 & up) will be held on Saturday, June 17. All girls and boys Preteam (Hotshots, Jr. Bronze, Silver, Gold) will be held on either June 16 or 17, so please set both days aside until further notice. Girls & Boys Teams do not participate in the recital.

It's actually a great weekend to have the entire family come and watch your child's accomplishments! Classes will be grouped by separate time blocks. Each recital lasts about one hour followed by a one-half hour awards ceremony. Your child's final schedule and specific time block will be published towards the end of May.

We do charge an admission fee for all spectators, \$5.00/advance, \$6.00/June 16 & 17. Gymnasts do not pay to attend their own recital, however, there is an admission fee if they attend any other recital time block. Parents who have children in more than one time block must inform the office when purchasing tickets so their ticket will be marked for re-entry to those time blocks. Advance ticket sales will begin on May 30. The doors will be locked between recitals and two lines will be formed outside, one for advance ticket holders (who will be allowed in first) and another for those who need to buy tickets, so if you don't want to wait until all ticket holders are seated first, you may want to consider purchasing your tickets in advance. There will be plenty of seating available. The bleachers in the gym will be opened which seat approximately 250 in addition to use of the mezzanine which allows for great viewing and video taping. Since there will be lines formed outside the doors for the next recital group, parents should hang onto children's clothing as cubby boxes will not be accessible after your recital. Everyone will enter from the front lobby and then exit through the side door area (next to the garage door) in the gym.

THE CUBBY BOX AREA WILL BE CLOSED. PARENTS SHOULD HANG ON TO THE KIDS SHOES, ETC. AND NOT USE THE CUBBY BOXES. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED UPSTAIRS OR IN THE FRONT LOBBY ENTRANCE AFTER YOUR RECITAL. EVERYONE WILL EXIT FROM THE REAR OF THE GYM.

If your child is enrolled in more than one class, please let the office know which class recital they want to perform with. They may perform with both classes in which they are enrolled and will receive a trophy and a medal.

A trophy will be awarded to each gymnast who meets the following criteria:

- Child MUST attend the recital
- Must be enrolled in Session 5 (May 1 - June 24)
- Session 5 tuition and any outstanding balances must be paid in full by Apr. 22.
